Real Risks

- Shadow AI: Enterprise Risk at a Glance – [BlackFog](#)
 - 63% of respondents believe it is acceptable to use AI tools without IT oversight
 - 51% admit to integrating AI tools with other work systems/apps without IT's approval or oversight.
- Cost of a Data Breach 2026 – [IBM](#)
 - Security incidents involving an organization's shadow AI more than doubled to 43% in 2026 leading to higher average breach costs this year (\$5.39M) vs last year (\$4.63M)
 - Impacts: Data loss/compromise (49%), operational disruption(42%), reputational damage (35%)
